Caring Cards

Our ladies of L.I.F.T. create beautiful greeting cards to brighten the days of parishioners and others who need a note of encouragement or fellowship. Call the church office if you know someone who could benefit from hearing from us.

Shepherd's Cupboard

This mission helps bridge a gap for parishioners or people within our West Side community who find they are a little short until their regular resources are available again. All requests are to go through the Church office.

Caring Closet

In support of the Caring Closet at the Lancaster Baptist Church, parishioners can either drop off donations of clothing and other small household articles directly to the Lancaster Baptist Church (Tues-Fri 9-3) or bring your donation to our church and place it in the cubby in the Narthex. Volunteers will transport them to Lancaster Baptist.

Food Bank

We support the West Side Food bank by collecting nonperishable food donations as well as monetary donations.

Donations of food can be placed in the bench in our front hall. A volunteer will deliver the food to the food bank.

Monetary donations can be placed in the collection plate. Please make sure you indicate Food Bank on the envelope.

Once a month, September to June, various groups within the church host a monthly luncheon for the parishioners after Sunday service. This is a wonderful time of fellowship and of course, good food.

Christmas Baskets

Good Shepherd provides 30+ families with food hampers which include a Christmas meal, supplies for one week of groceries and gifts for children. In the fall we publish the food list so parishioners can pick up supplies when they are on sale. In November, following Remembrance Day, a Christmas Tree with food tags and tags for children on our list will be placed in the Narthax where you can pick what you want to donate. We also accept cash donations which cover perishable food items.

Camp Medley Sponsorships
